Phonics

Activities in this Lesson: Bible Lesson, Science, Language Arts, Verse, Math, Color, Story Time, Music, Arts & Crafts, Math/Language Arts/Bible/Arts & Crafts Activity

Bible Reference: Genesis 1:11-13.

Bible Concept to Present: God made many things.

Bible Lesson: Review the lesson from Lesson 41. Have the students draw some of the things they have learned about bushes and what grows on and lives in bushes. Use rosemary. Remind them that plants and trees are important.

Science: Bring some herbs and spices for the lesson. Examples: oregano, rosemary, bay leaves, etc. Let the children smell and taste the spices. Spices are dry seeds, pods, or fruits. Check on the garden seeds that were prepared for the lesson.

Language Arts: If you can purchase some herbs and spices, have the students create a painting with glue and herbs. Then sprinkle the glue with different kinds of herbs and spices. Let the children smell good wherever it is hung.

Phonics: Review the letter Mm.

Teach the small letter m. Write some words from stories or activities that tie this letter to the small m that begins the words. Read the words and have the students trace the m in the air. Common words: made, make, map, must, my. Vocabulary words: map, medium.

Do the Lesson 42 Phonics worksheet. The letters of the alphabet are displayed on the worksheet. As the students get better at letter recognition, have them trace the letters between the guide lines. Remind the students that they can color the letters as they trace.

Reading: Dictate a description of an object. Have the students write the word for the object.

Trace the letters **M** and **m** with your finger. Can you see the letters **Mm** at the beginning of the words **muskrat**, **mink**, **moose**, **mouse**, and **muskox**?
